Weary Shoreline: The Chesapeake's Death By A Thousand Cuts

MPT explores how failure to enforce one of the state's most important environmental laws is contributing to the decline of the Chesapeake Bay's health. *Weary Shoreline* scrutinizes the impact of Critical Area violations on Chesapeake Bay water quality and its ecosystem in heavily and sparsely-populated regions. The program captures violations on tape and brings both little-known and high-profile cases to light on the Nanticoke, Patuxent, Magothy, West, Rhodes and Severn Rivers. Included in the program are the controversial issues of construction on Dobbins Island and Little Island in the Magothy River.
