May 6, 2008**

Board Members Present: Fran Kuhne, Rae Regula, Bonnie Howatt, Rich Fenton, Rick Watts and Bud Jenkins. **Guests:** Senator Bryan Simonaire and Mr. Thompson.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30PM at the home of Rich Fenton.

Motion made to approve the meeting notes from the April 2008 meeting. This motion seconded. All were in favor so it carried.

Membership: \$9,700 collected, 120 of 189 paid, compared to 151 from last year. Second notices will go out this month. 46 paid \$50, six of those households decreased their dues from \$100, and 74 paid \$100.

Park: Bud reported that the grass at the Park has been cut 2 times. Bud noted that the grass needs to be cut more frequently during the spring season. Bud said that the drain at the West end of Edgewater Road needs to be cleaned out after every rain due to clogging from debris. Bud would also like to replace the swings at the Park with soft seat swings and add one to the old tire swing area. Bud would also like to remove the old monkey bars and add new mulch to the playground area. Motion to allot \$200.00 for new playground equipment. Seconded. All in favor.

Pier: Rich reported that the water has been turned on. Rich also has a plumber giving an estimate on installing the water filter system and plumbing pipe repairs at the pier. Eighteen of the thirty slips have paid to date.

A reminder to all who frequent the use of the Pier - **PLEASE DO NOT LITTER!** Let's keep our areas clean - PLEASE take any trash home with you and discard of fish and bait remains properly.

Entertainment: No Report.

Beach: Board approved a refund of \$25.00 to the Blankenships for partial use of Beach Area due to inclement weather.

A motion to institute a Policy for Beach Area Rentals: Members of NS can reserve the Beach Area for a \$50 fee. If reservation is cancelled within 48 hours of use, Member will receive a full refund. Deposit can be applied to a future date due to inclement weather or rescheduling of event. Seconded. All in favor.

Rick Scruggs negotiated to have the Park, Pier & Beach cut by George's Lawn Service for one fee, which is very reasonable. Motion was made to hire Mr. Gonzales for the grass mowing of all three areas. Seconded. All in favor.

Roads & Zoning: Received an application from Mark & Lisa Stamper at 405 Dobbins Lane to add a new shed to existing car port. Motion was made for approval with clarification of the 10' set back and county permit. This was seconded. All approved so it carried.

Clara Bartholomee requested approval to take down a dead pine tree. Motion for approval. Seconded. All in favor.

Mr. Thompson submitted application and drawings for a new front porch, siding, and new deck to the south side of home and existing patio on west side at 416 Park Creek Court. Mr. Thompson has met all setbacks, is securing all permits, and has received required signatures. Motion to approve. Seconded. All in favor.

An application for a privacy fence was submitted. The covenants require Board approval for a fence and the Board's policy has always been to not allow fences except where required by county/state law. Motion to deny request. Seconded. All in Favor.

Garden Club: No Report.

Old Business: Rick Watts and Bonnie Howatt looked into various alternatives to the North Shore CD. Motion was made to close CD at Arundel Savings and open a Money Market account with Corus Bank. Seconded. All in favor.

New Business: Fran was contacted on a safety issue regarding a swimming pool that is not enclosed. The homeowner is working with the county on this and the pool is securely covered at this time.

Fran was contacted about middle school age children putting plastic forks in mailboxes, peeking in windows, and generally being mischievous. This is not destructive but the energy needs to be redirected. North Shore at one time had a Junior & Senior Council for the middle school and high school age children which had planned activities. These groups were led by parents and interested adults. Anyone interested in reviving these programs contact the board.

District 31 State Senator Bryan Simonaire attended the meeting. Senator Simonaire would like to be the contact point for any issues concerning the North Shore Community. (See letter)
