**Roads and Zoning:** Lois Warner regarding mosquito spraying: We received a letter from the Maryland Department of Agriculture, Office of Plant Industries and Pest Management. Our community participation application is due by May 15th. This application is for adult mosquito control service only. Neighbors requesting exemption from spraying can contact the Program Supervisor for Anne Arundel County at 410-841-5870 or [www.mda.state.md.us](http://www.mda.state.md.us). We are reminded that ULV spray treatment of adult tiger mosquitoes is most effective when conducted in conjunction with community cleanup efforts. As homeowners we can be proactive in the effort to control mosquitoes by becoming aware of backyard breeding sites. Check out the MDA for more information.

Just a reminder: If you own a boat or any vehicle which doesn't sit in your driveway, please make sure it isn't blocking the road. North Shore is such a beautiful neighborhood. Take a look around and see what you can do to keep it that way, such as keeping a clean yard, trash cans out of sight, etc.

If someone is on your property or community property, and you have reason to suspect they shouldn't be, don't confront them yourself. Call the police.

**New Business:** The following was brought to the attention of the Board: Recently, a dog in the neighborhood, which was in it's own yard, was attacked by another dog which was not on a leash. Animal control was called, and the attacking dog was picked up. **There have been numerous reports of dogs running loose in the neighborhood. A reminder: Anne Arundel County laws state that animals must either be on their owner's property, or must be leashed and in the control of a responsible person. Anyone in violation of this law is subject to a fine. The Board will write a letter to Animal Control asking them to make regular patrols through the community.**

Another item of interest: There was a report recently of a party at the beach pavilion with very loud music. The noise was very disturbing to several neighbors. A reminder: There is an 11:00 PM curfew, and we ask that you be considerate when having a party at the beach. There was a report of miscellaneous signs being taken from front yards. The ones found will be in the shed at the marina. Please feel free to look in and see if yours is in there.

## Rough Seas in Park Creek

Boaters in Park Creek are reminded that when water skiing or towing tubes, the boat must be at least 100 feet from piers, pilings, other boats, the shore, and any people in the water (DNR Regulation #08.18.01.08.06).

On a temporary basis, a buoy has been placed at 100 feet in front of a grouping of several piers on the creek where boaters seem to be violating that required distance. The buoy should help boaters to recognize the proper distance to maintain.

In addition, please try to use a shallow draft boat to do the towing so that the wake is not excessive. It appears that some of the towing boats are just too big and create too much wake. It has become considerably rougher in the creek due to these larger wakes.

DNR Regulation # 08.738.1 prohibits operation of a vessel in a manner that may endanger a person or property. These large wakes can cause injury and property damage, not to mention beach erosion.

Even boaters other than those towing skiers or tubes should try to slow down in the creek and be aware of the damage that these large and unnecessary wakes can cause. We all know the rule "you are responsible for your wake."

### Sweet Pepper-Tomato Topping:

**MAKES ABOUT 3 CUPS; PREP: 15 MIN.,**

**STAND: 15 MIN.**

*This recipe is best when freshly made; however, you can cover and chill the mixture (without basil) up to two hours. Just know that the texture of the tomatoes will soften.*

2 Tbsp. olive oil

1 Tbsp. white wine vinegar

1 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. coarsely ground pepper

2 large tomatoes, seeded and chopped

1 yellow bell pepper, chopped

1 green bell pepper, chopped

4 green onions, sliced

1/2 cup pitted Spanish olives, quartered

1/2 cup golden raisins, coarsely chopped

1/4 cup firmly packed fresh basil leaves, chopped

1. Stir together first 4 ingredients in a large bowl. Add tomatoes and next 5 ingredients, tossing gently to combine. Let stand 15 minutes. Gently stir in basil just before serving. ●
