The meeting was called to order at 7:10PM at the home of Jennifer Harris.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from the December 6, 2011 meeting. Motion approved by Rae Regula, seconded by Jennifer Harris. All were in favor, motion carried.

BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

Treasurer: *In an effort to save paper/printing costs and more accurately reflect the board meeting (the board does not read or review the entire report item by item), the Treasurer's full report will now be on the website only www.Northshoreaa.com. Thank you.* Bonnie Howatt reported that our beginning balance was \$13,715 with expenses including the Christmas open house bringing the closing balance to \$12,960. The capital fund has \$15,572.
