**MINUTES FOR NORTH SHORE
ASSOCIATION**

Board Members Present: Marty Gavin, Jennifer King, Jennifer Harris, Wayne Bartholomee, Amy Bartholomee, Sarah Ann Parsons, Rae Regula, Brenda DeRemer, Bonnie Howatt, Roberta Watts

The meeting was called to order at 7:15PM at the North Shore on the Magothy Community Beach. *Jennifer King moved to approve the minutes from June 2nd, 2012. Motion approved by Jennifer Harris, seconded by Marty Gavin. All were in favor, motion carried.*

BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

Treasurer: Bonnie Howatt reported that we started with a balance of \$23,656, collected \$1332 in receipts and paid \$1004 leaving a balance of \$23,984 in the main account. Family Day expenses totaled \$436, which was within budget. No change in the Capital fund. *See the Treasurer's full report on the website www.Northshoreaa.com. Thank you.*

Beach: Marty Gavin reported that there have been a couple rentals. He pointed out to the board the corner pole of the pavilion that has sunk several inches, causing the eaves to slope down at the corner. He expects the easiest solution would be to jack up the corner and replace the pole with an adjustable lally column.

Marty would like to restrict the use of the garbage cans to community functions. There was some concern that removing the trash cans would only create more litter at the beach. *The board would like to remind all beach users to take their trash and belongings with them.*

Marty reminds the board that the nettle net needs to be installed soon. He recommends spreading it out to dry on July 4th after the parade and setting it up on Saturday July 7th at 9am.

Entertainment: Jennifer Harris reported that she has not received confirmation from the Lake Shore fire department about the use of their truck for the July 4th Parade. Roberta Watts recommended that we get a BGE truck to lead the march to the beach! In any case, the banner is in good condition for the parade, and Jennifer has all in order. The community crab feast will be September 22nd.

Garden Club: Sarah Ann Parsons reported that the Garden club is planning the Luau for Friday July 20th. This will be a potluck, BYOB event with the club providing non-alcoholic beverages and an assortment of food. There will be a wine basket raffle.

Greater Pasadena Council: Jennifer King reported for Robin Gearhart-Sayler that the dues North Shore on the Magothy paid to the GPC will be going to the Mountain Road flag maintenance fund that has been taken over by the Pasadena Business Association.

Membership: No report.

Park: Rae Regula reported that she has replaced one of the basketball nets, and will need to secure both nets firmly to their hoops. She is happy with the new trash can and she is keeping the weeds trimmed at the playground. Rae reported that non-members have been reminded that the park is for members and their guests only.

Pier: Marty Gavin noted that he found non-members using the community pier for fishing and asked them to leave. Bonnie

Howatt and Jennifer King also had to ask non-members not to use the community boat ramp. *Please note that the boat ramp key is for member use only. Those wishing to help out a friend must still accompany that person to the ramp and supervise all ramp use.* Marty Gavin also recommended assigning a smaller slip that is available to someone on the slip waitlist. Currently 23 slips are paid for.

Roads and Zoning: Wayne Bartholomee has received all outstanding tree removal applications (except Mother Nature's!). He recommends securing an attorney to review ongoing infractions to the North Shore covenants. Neighbors are reminded that the community covenants can be found on the website www.northshoreaa.com and that the Board takes seriously infractions such as unapproved fencing and property line setback encroachments.

Welcome: Brenda DeRemer knows of two new families to welcome and is getting their information.

Barnacle: Amy Bartholomee was congratulated on the special graduation issue of the Barnacle.

OLD BUSINESS: Marty Gavin met with a property owner who is applying for a variation on his shed's location within 7' of the property line when the county code is 8'.

Roberta Watts reported that Derek Fink's office is looking into changing the garbage pick-up day for our community.

Jennifer King met Jim Barker, Superintendent for Anne Arundel County's Department of Public Works, and he asked her to plot on a map the neighborhood storm drains that are actually clogged so that he can then get the

County to clear them out. Jennifer will share his information with Phil Gerber.

NEW BUSINESS: A neighbor on Park Creek reported a red kayak was cut from its cable and stolen from her pier on June 24th-25th. She has filed a police report but notes that anyone with information concerning this theft should contact a North Shore on the Magothy board member.

The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 7, 2012 at the community beach, 7PM. Jennifer King motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:25PM. Marty Gavin seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

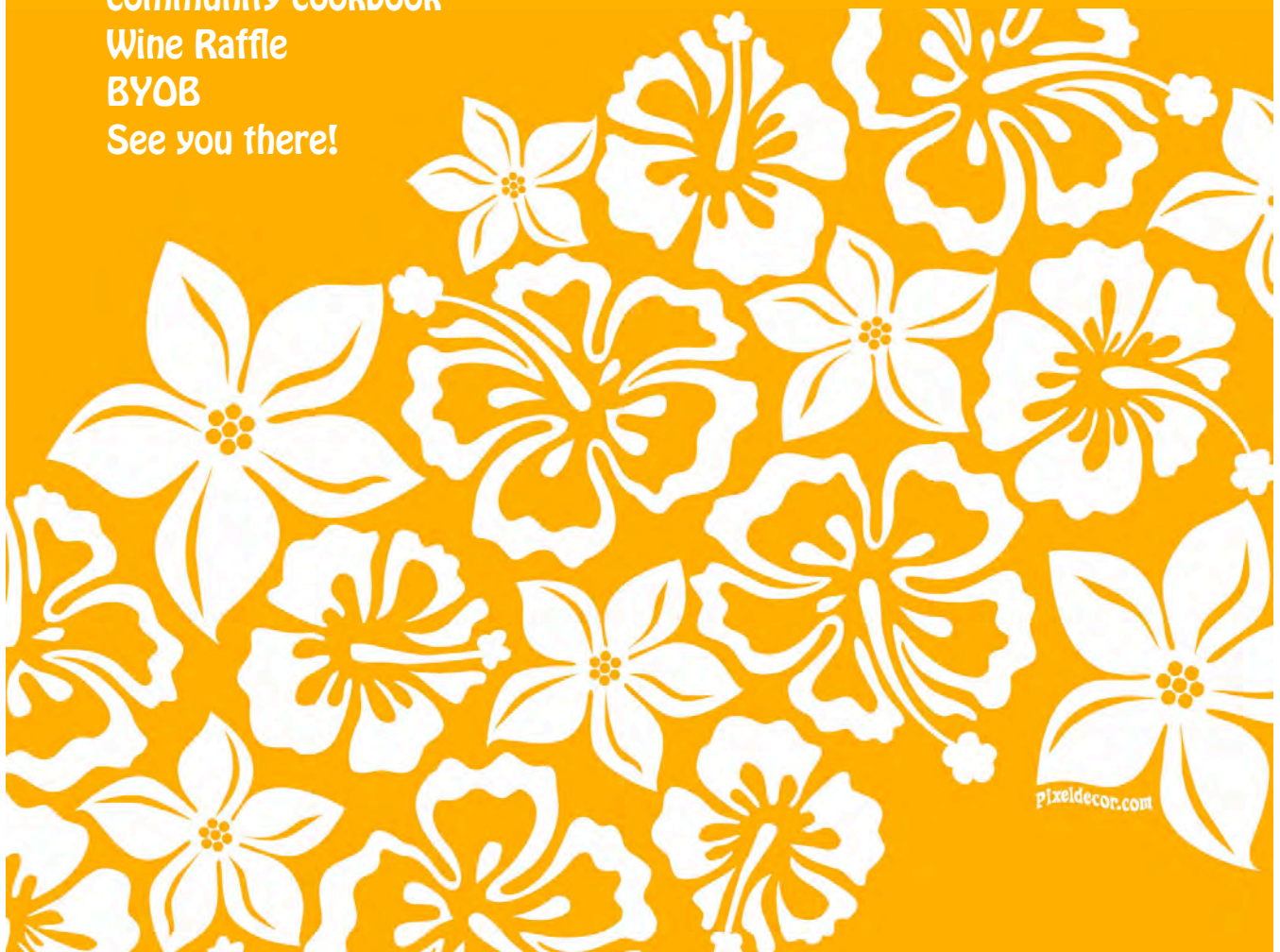
