MINUTES FOR NORTH SHORE ASSOCIATION

Board Members Present: Jennifer King, Jennifer Harris, Bonnie Howatt, Ted Tepper, Wayne Bartholomee, Phil Gerber, Rae Regula, Sarah Ann Parsons

Guests: None.

The meeting was called to order at 7:15PM at the Community Beach. *Jennifer King moved to approve the minutes from August 7th. The minutes are approved subject to the following correction: The Board of North Shore on the Magothy asks that boaters not tie their boats to the swim platform at the North Shore on the Magothy community beach. Motion to approve the corrected minutes seconded by Bonnie Howatt. All were in favor, motion carried.*

Jennifer King opened the meeting with the resignation of Marty Gavin. There will be a rearranging of current board members to fill the empty position, with an active search for new board members who will be voted in at the General Meeting in February. BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

Treasurer: Bonnie Howatt reported that we started the month with \$24,840 in the general fund. She had \$679 in receipts and \$4,180 in expenses. The month closed with \$21,340 in the general fund and \$15,644 in the capital fund. *See the Treasurer's full report on the website www.Northshoreaa.com. Thank you.*

Beach: Jennifer King reported that she and Ted Tepper have taken over the Beach Chair for Marty Gavin.

Garden Club: Sarah Ann Parsons reported that there was no Luau this year due to a very determined Mother Nature. The cookbook recipes came rolling in, thanks to our active community and this promises to be a true keepsake for the community. Thanks to Jennifer Harris for spearheading this fundraising project!

Greater Pasadena Council: No report.

Membership: Phil Gerber reported that he has received several dues after sending out late notices for North Shore on the Magothy's membership. He will submit an updated membership list to be published in the *Barnacle*.

Pier: Ted Tepper reported that he needs a map for the pier so that the numbering will make sense. The electrical work is complete, repair and all. Thanks to Ted Tepper for all his help with finalizing that project!

Roads and Zoning: Wayne Bartholomee reported that several neighbors lost trees due to acts of nature and have had them removed.

Park: Rae Regula reported that the grass is creating a cushion under the play equipment and the rest of the park is kept in shape thanks to the mowing efforts of Cody Schell. She has fixed the basketball net numerous times, and cleaned up lumber strewn in the play area. Rae has scheduled the Community Cleanup day to coincide with Dumpster drop-off.

North Shore Clean up day will be on Saturday October 13, rain date is Sunday the 14th. **All able body members should come to the community Park on Saturday, starting at 9am.**

The Dumpster will be at the Community Beach on October 17-19.

Welcome: No report.

OLD BUSINESS: Pavilion repairs update: Ted Tepper researched the pavilion repairs and has received some information from AA County on what is needed and a preliminary estimate for framing a new roof. The costs of the pavilion repair range from a roof replacement of \$ 11,600 (Piling support and roofing would be additional) to \$30,000 for a total overhaul. Several members of the board asked that a notice be placed in the *Barnacle* asking our members for alternative repair ideas, materials and labor to help bring the cost of the pavilion repair down. The main issues are the failing piling at the NE corner of the pavilion and the sagging eaves. Anyone

NEW BUSINESS: Phil Gerber will continue to pursue the storm drainage concerns, using Jennifer King's contact in the County as an additional resource.

Roberta Watts motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:35PM. Phil Gerber seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Police Warn Residents About Break-ins

Residents who live around the area of Boulevard Park, off Mountain Road, recently received a police department robocall saying there had been a series of break-ins in the neighborhood.

Police confirmed that about 10 residential burglaries have taken place in that area since the beginning of September.

"Four incidents took place on North Carolina Avenue at different times along with two incidents on Kentucky Avenue, one on Tennessee Avenue, one on Pacific Road, one on Potomac Road and one on Hickory Point Road," according to Anne Arundel County police spokesman Justin Mulcahy.

The incidents reportedly occurred during the day and evening. Mulcahy said that in many

cases, the homes were not secured and money or property were taken.

Police remind residents to:

- Lock windows and doors (of homes and vehicles)
- Use exterior lighting
- Report suspicious activity
