

## North Shore Association Community Park Rules

This is a summary of the basic rules and regulations for the use of the North Shore Association Kenneth R. Nash Memorial Park property. The Kenneth R. Nash Memorial Park is adjacent to the community pier. It is designed as a recreational facility for the residents of North Shore and, more particularly, their children. The following rules are established for safe and enjoyable use of the park. A complete set of rules and regulations is available from the Park Chairman or the North Shore Board of Governors.

1. The park is open from 7 am until dark.
2. Children under the age of five must be supervised.
3. The area around the playground equipment is reserved for that equipment.
4. Ball games should be played in open areas only. No "hard ball" baseball games are allowed.
5. Parking at the park is limited to the road shoulder along the perimeter of the park.
6. Large group picnics must be arranged with the Park Committee Chair.
7. No open fires are permitted on the park.
8. The park is not intended for water access. No wading or swimming is allowed.
9. Please keep the lot clean and place litter in the containers provided or take it home.
10. Those using the playground equipment do so at their own risk and should exercise courtesy and care.
11. Any serious injuries sustained while on park property should be reported immediately to the Park Committee Chair.
12. Any defective playground equipment should be reported.
13. Park users should respect the property of park neighbors.
14. Any glass containers or bottles are strictly prohibited on park property.
15. Park property improvements and equipment are restricted to North Shore Association members and their guests.
