More later, first the news. We are making good progress at the Park. Drainage was identified in the survey as the No. 1 problem. We have discovered a drain system for the park which was covered over and not functioning - sort of like an ancient Roman ruin. We have uncovered it and it has helped already. For the remaining areas, we intend to improve drainage by filling in the low spots with material from the playground. That gets us to why we need your help on July 31. We must strip the playground area down to its base in order to rid the weeds and prepare for new playground mulch. Brian Siwinski and Bob Gardner have volunteered to provide and operate the heavy equipment needed for the stripping. We will need volunteers to provide and operate shovels, wheelbarrows and paint brushes. We anticipate refurbishing the park in one day, less time if more volunteers pitch in. We will need at least a dozen people to help starting at 9 a.m. July 31. Any amount of time helping at any point of the day is needed. Just painting the monkey bars

As your NSA Treasurer I have attempted to simplify our association's records. I am recording all income and expenses as generated by or charged to specific sub committees of the association. For example, payment to BGE will include two charges, one each to the Beach and Marina Committees. All general expenses, such as Insurance Payments, Taxes, government fees, Porta Potty expense, etc. are charged to the North Shore Board.

As always, detailed information on any Committee's Expense or Income is available to any North Shore Association member in good standing.

As directed by the February Annual General Membership Meeting, and with approval of the BOD and the Marina Committee, we closed the Pier Committee Checking Account, withdrawing the ending balance of \$22,312.43. Along with \$2,687.57 from the Associations General Fund, we opened a Twelve Month Renewable CD. This CD is assigned as the Marina Committee Prudent Reserve Fund, and requires three (3) of four (4) signatures to withdraw or transfer monies. At this time two of the signers are BOD members not on the Marina Committee, and two signers as members of the Marina Committee. Therefore, in theory, withdrawal or transfer of any monies requires at least one member of each the Marina Committee and at least one non-Marina Committee BOD to insure some degree of Checks & Balances. I personally commend all parties involved with settling an emotional issue in a fashion where all voices were heard and honored.
