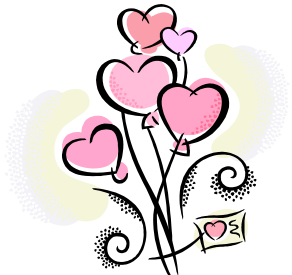

#### BEACH:

It was reported that the county has awarded us a grant of \$785 to supplement our cost for the replacement of the sea nettle net. Forms need completion before we actually get the money and the project must be completed by June 30. Nancy will follow up with the measurements and purchase of the net.

Regarding the permit process for the grading of the beach, the checklist for the permit and the application are being reviewed for engineering readiness so that it can be submitted to the county.

The recent survey of the community beach property indicated that there was an encroachment and a certified letter will be sent regarding this encroachment.

#### PIER:

No report except Bill Morris announced that ice eaters will be activated when needed.

#### ROADS AND ZONING:

Jon Williams submitted an application to replace his beach steps that were damaged in Hurricane Isabel. The application was complete and the board approved it.

Dean Hildebrand submitted his completed application for improvements to his property. The application has already been approved pending neighbor signatures and it is noted that those signatures have been obtained.

An updated site plan was presented by Charlene Wroten and Bart Arconti for

their home to be built. Their attempt to obtain the appropriate signatures from the surrounding neighbors was unsuccessful as indicated in a letter accompanying their application. Since they met all the covenant restrictions and have the proper county permits, the board voted to approve their application.

## North Shore Galley From the kitchen of Nancy Anello

### Creamy Pesto Rigatoni with Chunky Tomato Vinaigrette

4 cups diced seeded tomato (about 4 large tomatoes)  
1/2 cup chopped red onion  
3 tablespoons balsamic vinegar  
1 tablespoon olive oil  
1 cup fat-free, less-sodium chicken broth  
3/4 cup fresh basil leaves  
1/4 cup (1 ounce) grated fresh Parmesan cheese, divided  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon black pepper  
3 garlic cloves or 1 1/2 teaspoons bottled minced garlic  
1 (8-ounce) block fat-free cream cheese, softened  
6 cups hot cooked rigatoni (about 3/4 pound uncooked pasta)  
1/4 cup pine nuts, toasted

Combine first 4 ingredients in a bowl, and set aside.

Combine broth, basil, 2 tablespoons Parmesan, salt, pepper, garlic, and cream cheese in a blender; process until smooth. Combine basil mixture and rigatoni in a Dutch oven, and cook over low heat until thoroughly heated. Spoon pasta onto each of 6 plates. Top with tomato vinaigrette, 2 tablespoons Parmesan, and pine nuts.

**Yield: 6 servings (serving size: 1 cup pasta, 2/3 cup tomato vinaigrette, 1 teaspoon parmesan cheese, 2 teaspoons pine nuts)**

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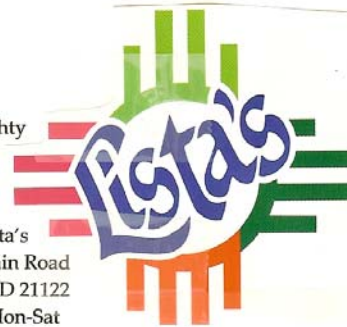
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
