The meeting was called to order at 7:10PM at the home of Bill Morris.

**GARDEN CLUB:** A salute to the Garden Club for the very successful Luau. Despite the rain about 80 people gathered at the beach pavilion which had been transformed into a tropical paradise. Special thanks to Nancy Anello for coming up with the Luau idea, and making it happen.

The Garden Club is a great asset to North Shore with all of the work in maintaining the gardens and the great activities for FUN Raisers. Thanks to all of you!!

**MEMBERSHIP:** Nancy reported there are no new members. Membership stands at 160.

**PARK:** Two new basketball nets have been installed. Also Bud and Sarah have been raking grass, trimming, weeding and edging the playground and garden areas. In addition the storm drains have been cleared. The next project will probably be delivery and leveling of additional playground mulch.

**PIER:** A new stainless steel fish cleaning station has been set up at the Pier. The station has running water. When you use it please clean up and take the fish carcasses home with you. Bill reported the new well pump is half horsepower which should give good service. The boat slip to the right of the boat ramp is now empty and can be used for temporary tie up by persons launching their boats. The pier facility has 4 ice eaters to use this winter. Please keep the pier area free of trash, like boat lines, cans, etc. Bill is obtaining estimates to repair the bulkhead by the boat ramp. He is looking to do this work next year. Also next year, new crush and run will be put down on the pier road.

**ROADS AND ZONING:** Application for the addition of dormers to the home at 457 Edgewater was approved by the board. The board has received complaints about boats stored in front yards. When keeping boats in the yard please keep them as out of sight as possible. The board has received a complaint that it appears a business is being run out of a home in North Shore.

**BEACH:** The area where the tennis court was removed has been seeded, fertilized, lymed and strawed. The Beach has been booked for 10/22/06 pending receipt of rental fee.

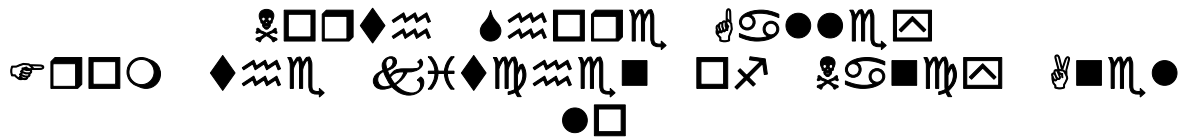
