Community Beach Rules

These are the rules and regulations for the use of the North Shore Community Beach property. The rules and regulations for the Park and Marina are available from the appropriate chairperson.

1. The use of the community beach facility is reserved for North Shore Association members and their guests.
2. Guests must be personally accompanied by a North Shore Association member when using the community beach and launch area.
3. Parents are responsible at all times for children's safety and conduct in the beach area whether they, the parents, are in attendance or not.
4. Dogs must be leashed, cleaned up after and under control at all times
5. No organized beach events will be held except on approval of the Beach Committee.
6. The use of the associations grill will be determined by the Beach Committee for an additional deposit.
7. The volleyball net is available to North Shore Association members but the Association does not provide volleyballs.
8. All trash resulting from events held at the beach must be bagged and removed from the premises.
9. All glass containers are prohibited.
10. Roughhousing is not permitted.
11. The beach is closed to all at 11 pm, except for approved Association functions.
12. Cars are to be parked only in prescribed areas.
13. There is no lifeguard on duty at the beach.
14. No diving off the platform is permitted.
15. All people will swim at their own risk.
16. All people using the beach do so at their own risk and will be solely responsible for their actions.
17. No motorized craft is permitted at the beach.
18. Non-motorized boats may be beached only in the area designated by the Beach Committee.
19. The launch facility is available for North Shore Association members and their guests only.
20. Launching of all craft shall be accomplished manually.
21. All complaints will be referred to the Beach Committee.
22. It is the responsibility of all North Shore Association members to abide by these rules. Any person who violates the above rules is subject to the withdrawal of the privileges of using the community area.
