Carolyn Marie Paul, 74, a resident of Pasadena since 1964, died Wednesday, April 5, 2017, at Baltimore Washington Medical Center.



Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Report for February and March 2017

The beginning balance for February was \$10,611. There was \$6,130 in revenue from dues (\$4,320) and Marina donations (\$1,810). The expenses were \$370 with the bills being BGE for both sites, copies for the annual meeting and membership mailing expenses. The CD start amount was \$28,339 and end amount for February was \$28,359. The March ending amount was \$28,384. The CD matures in May and will not be moved until then.

The March revenue was \$9,579 which included dues, marina donations, slip fees and keys for the marina ramp. The checking account for the marina fund was opened and had \$3,975 by the end of March. The expenses were moving the money to the marina fund (\$3,975) and the BGE bill for both sites (\$18.61-beach and \$55.82 - pier).

We received a letter from The Maryland House of Delegates regarding a request for attendance by Nic Kipke, Meagan Simonaire and Bryan Simonaire to our next board meeting. I contacted their Legislative Aide and provided information on where and when. Unfortunately, they are all booked on May 2nd. We will forward the location of the June meeting when available. Hopefully they can join us as we have several issues within the community, that require their attention.

We are asking the community at large to assist in our quest to keep the 2 mile stretch of North Shore Road free and clear of debris. We very much appreciate our neighbors who do an occasional clean up but isn't this an unnecessary task? Do we really have neighbors who think it's ok to dispose of their unwanted garbage along the road? I would appreciate any input on how



to curb this offense. Please let me know if anyone has any suggestions.



**Shrimp and Bacon Salad Sliders
Recipe**

TOTAL
20 Minutes

YIELD
Serves 6

Creamy, celery-flecked shrimp salad has been served at luncheons throughout the South for years, and while we're fans of the traditional version, we are pretty into this

fresh new take as well. The addition of chopped basil, fresh lemon juice, fresh orange zest, fresh orange juice, and Old Bay make the mayonnaise dressing sing. And a little crispy, chopped bacon adds a nice bit of crunch, plus a hint of smokiness. You could serve this shrimp salad as-is over a bed of lettuce, but it's even more delicious spooned onto toasted slider buns and topped with thinly sliced tomatoes and a few basil leaves. The presentation is as good as the taste. The shrimp salad can be made up to one day ahead. Make sure to let it come to room temperature before serving. Can't eat shrimp? Substitute cooked lobster or scallops instead. Can't find slider buns? You can cut three hot dog buns (potato rolls are best) in half cross-wise to make six slider-sized buns. This recipe is perfect for the summer season when the seafood is fresh and it is on everyone's mind. Pull out this recipe for your next brunch. You may even want to save a few for a snack later in the day.

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh basil
- 1 1/2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice (from 1 lemon)
- 1/2 teaspoon orange zest plus 1 1/2 tsp. fresh juice (from 1 orange)
- 3/4 teaspoon Old Bay seasoning
- 3/4 pound chilled cooked shrimp, peeled and cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 6 bacon slices, cooked crisp and diced
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/4 teaspoon black pepper

- 6 slider buns
- 1 1/2 tablespoons salted butter, at room temperature
- 18 large fresh basil leaves
- 1-2 plum tomatoes, thinly sliced

How to Make

Preheat broiler with oven rack 8 to 10 inches from heat. Stir together mayonnaise, chopped basil, lemon juice, orange zest, orange juice, and Old Bay in a medium bowl. Fold in shrimp, bacon, salt, and pepper.

Split slider buns, and spread butter evenly on cut sides of buns. Place halves, butter side up, on a baking sheet; broil until light golden brown, about 3 minutes. Spoon about 1/4 cup shrimp mixture on each bottom half; top each with 3 basil leaves and 1 or 2 tomato slices. Cover with top slider bun halves, and serve immediately.
